



Barn Team Job Description

Reports to: Volunteer Manager

Position Summary: Assist Healing Reins with day-to-day barn and horse-related tasks, including but not limited to cleaning stalls, sweeping, cleaning tack, and assisting Instructors with preparing the arena for lessons.

Qualifications:

- All Barn Team members must have filled out the volunteer application and completed a background check if 18 or older.
- Minimum age of 12.
- Able to frequently stand, walk, bend, and lift up to 25 pounds.

Note: Attending Sidewalker and Horse Leader trainings are not mandatory but are highly encouraged, as assistance with bringing horses in and out of the barn is often needed.

Barn Team Responsibilities:

- Clean stalls, runs, and paddocks.
- Prepare tack for upcoming lessons and assist with putting tack away after lessons.
- Aid in maintaining cleanliness and order in the barn by performing tasks such as sweeping, wiping railings, and cleaning tack.
- If trained as a Horse Leader, bring horses in and out of the barn as needed.
- Work as a team with staff and other volunteers.
- Follow directions from Instructors.
- Ensure compliance with all Healing Reins policies.
